**Sandra Hutchens** is the 12<sup>th</sup> Orange County Sheriff and the first female Sheriff to be selected by the Board of Supervisors to serve the Orange County community. As Sheriff of Orange County, Sandra Hutchens leads the more than 3,800 sworn and professional men and women who serve in a number of diverse areas. The Sheriff's Department provides direct patrol services to more than 700,000 of the County's 3.1 Million residents, including twelve municipal cities via contract, as well as the County's harbors, John Wayne Airport, and the Orange County Transportation Agency. Sheriff Hutchens also oversees the operations of the 8<sup>th</sup> largest jail system in the nation.
