Jeanne Scheper is Assistant Professor of Gender and Sexuality Studies and a recipient of the Hellman Fellowship (2013-2014). Her research and teaching engages with the interdisciplinary fields of performance studies and visual culture; cultural studies; theories of race, gender, & sexuality and trans-Atlantic modernism. She has published scholarly essays in *African American Review*; *Feminist Studies*; *Camera Obscura*; and *Duke Journal of Gender Law and Policy*. Her current book project is "Moving Performances: Divas, Iconicity, and Remembering the Modern Stage." Before joining the faculty at UCI, she was Research Director for the Palm Center, a public policy think tank on sexual minorities in the military.
